When you are a schoolteacher, you have an entire community that understands what you do for a living--the good days and the bad ones. There is something universal about working in a school, no matter where you live.

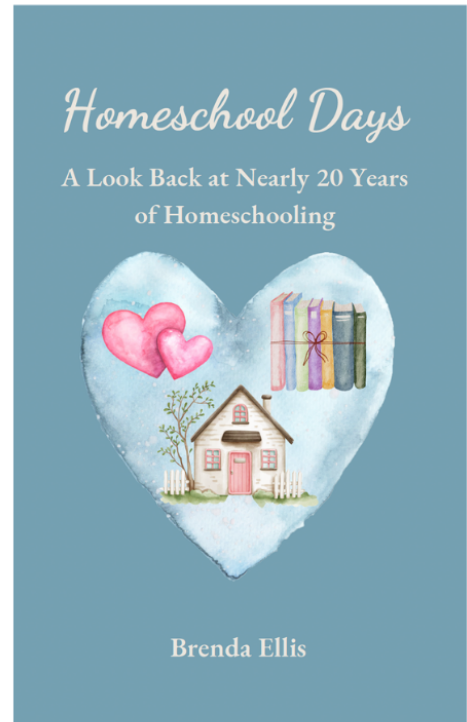
